

## PSI Exam Pattern

The Gujarat PSI exam pattern 2023 includes three major stages: prelims, mains and physical standard and physical efficiency test.

Candidates who pass these three rounds will be subjected to document verification, medical tests, and a personal interview. The details regarding the exam pattern for all the rounds are shared below.

### Physical Standard Test

## PSI Prelims Exam Pattern

A preliminary exam is the first phase of PSI exams.

- ◆ The exam will be held for 100 marks in total.
- ◆ Each question carries 1 mark.
- ◆ There will be a negative marking of 0.25 marks for every wrong answer.
- ◆ Minimum qualifying marks shall be 40%.
- ◆ Mark 'Not Attempted' in case you do not wish to attend the question. If left blank, it will result in negative marking.
- ◆ Exam will be conducted in Gujarati Language Medium.
